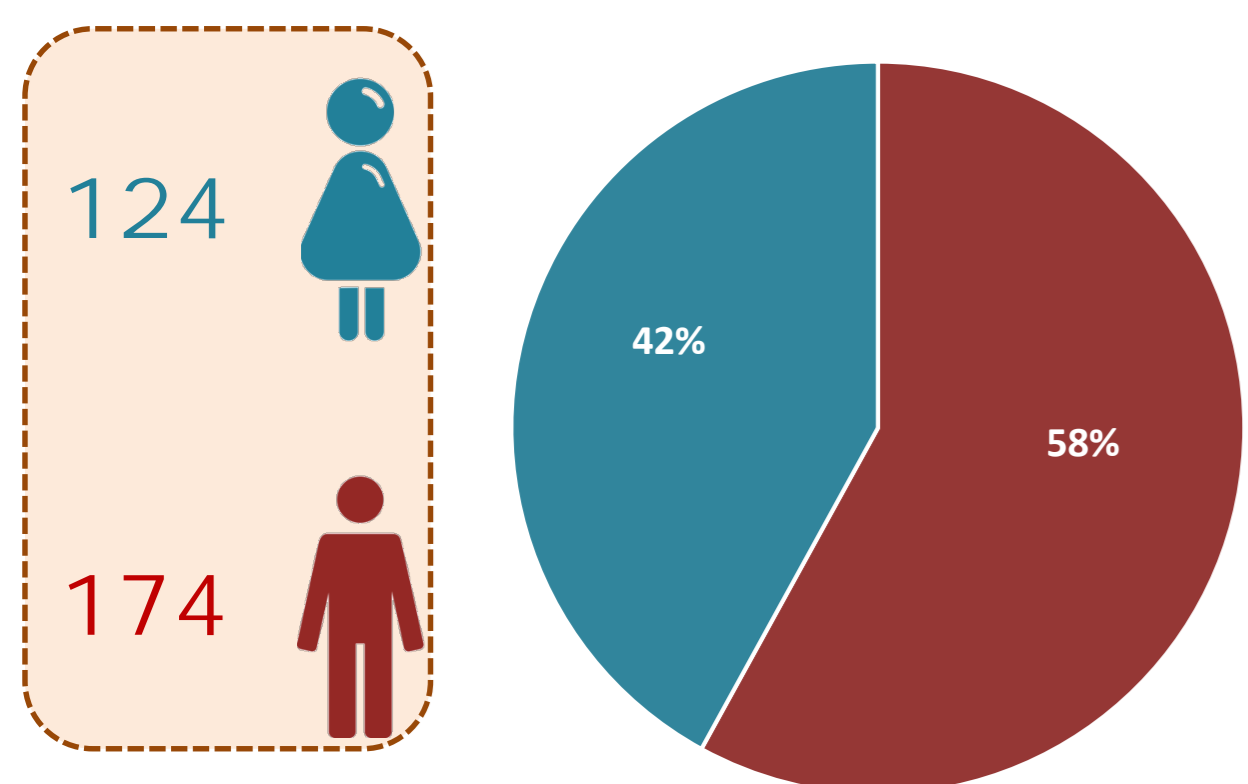

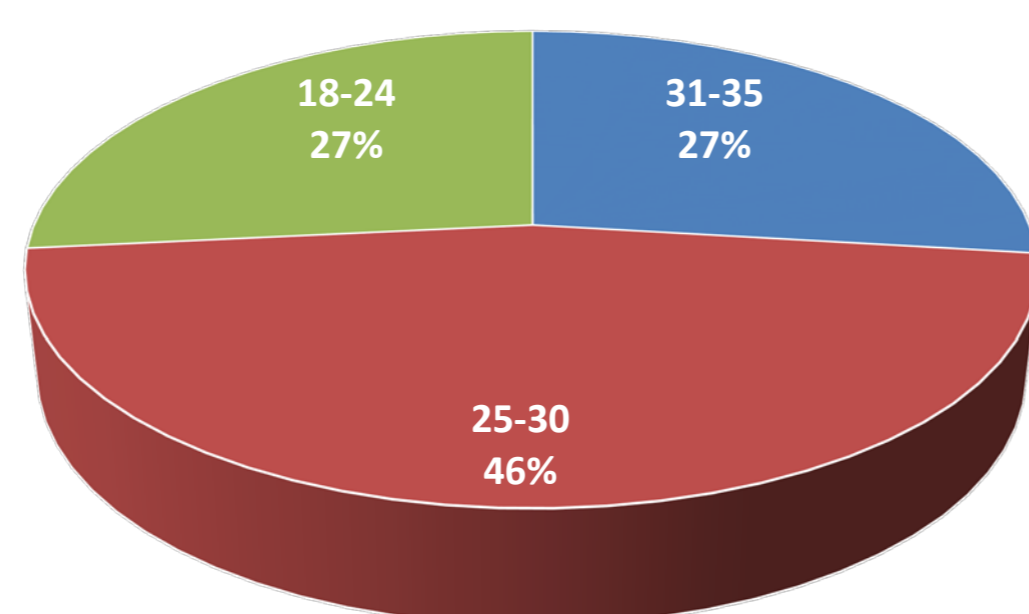


Profile of participants of the survey

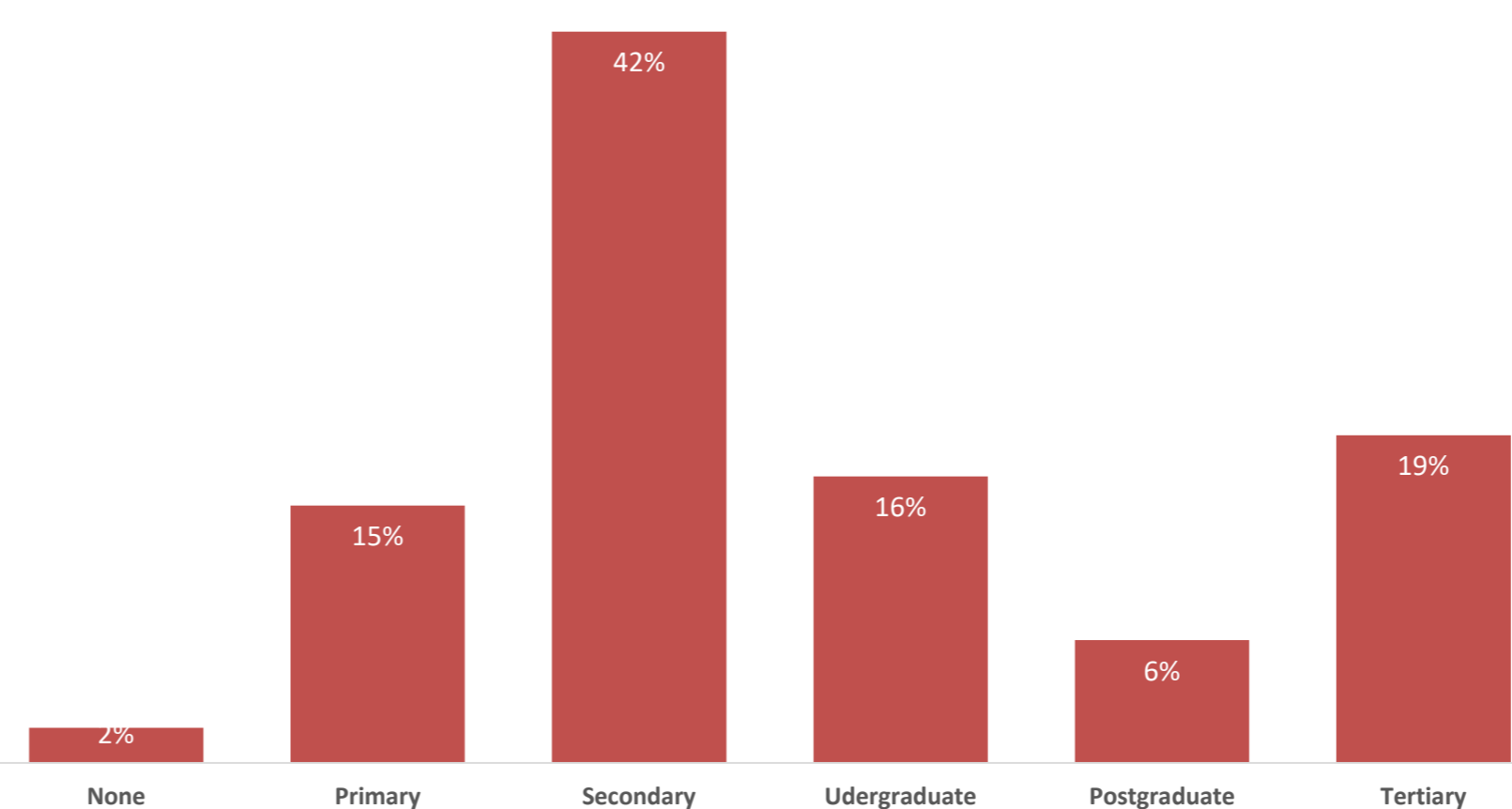
Gender composition



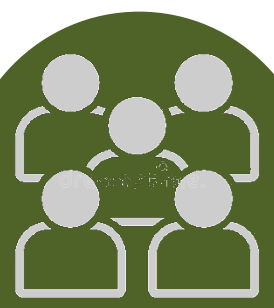
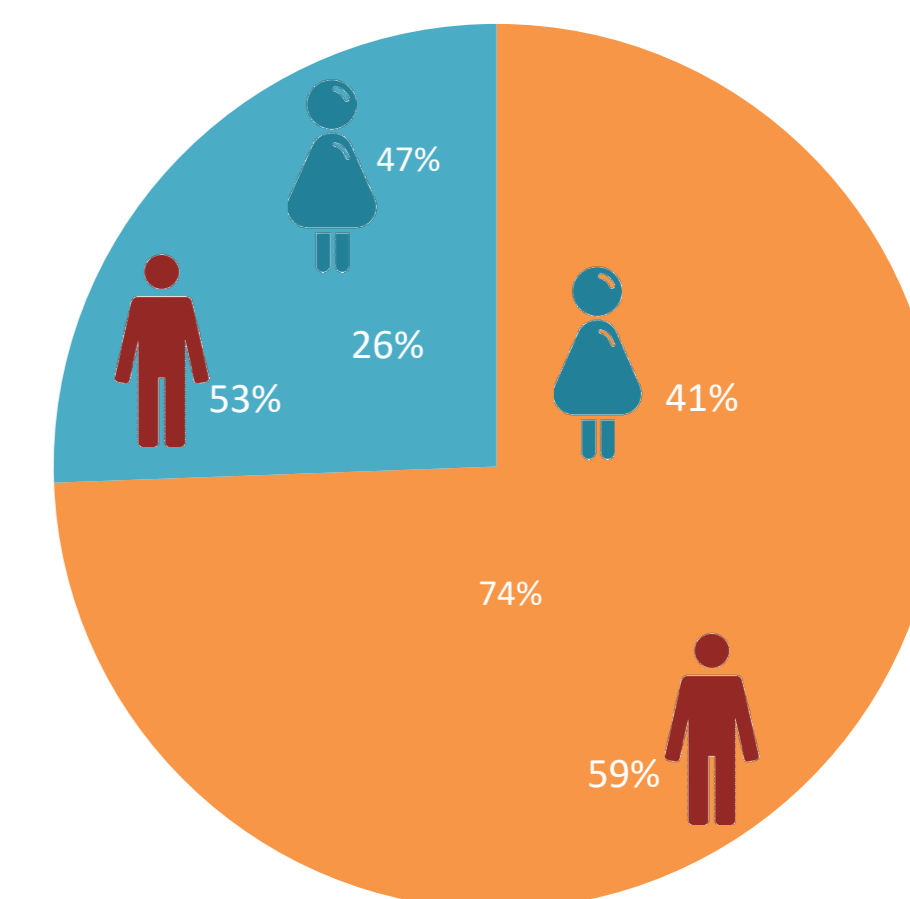
Age composition

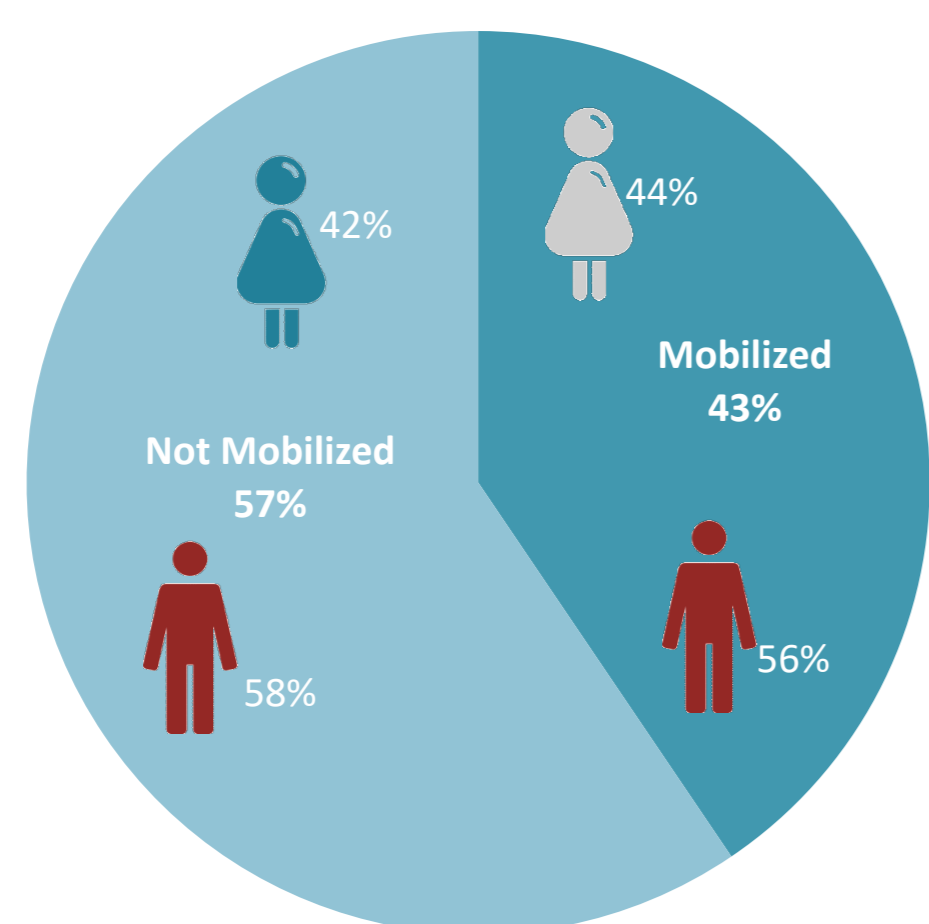

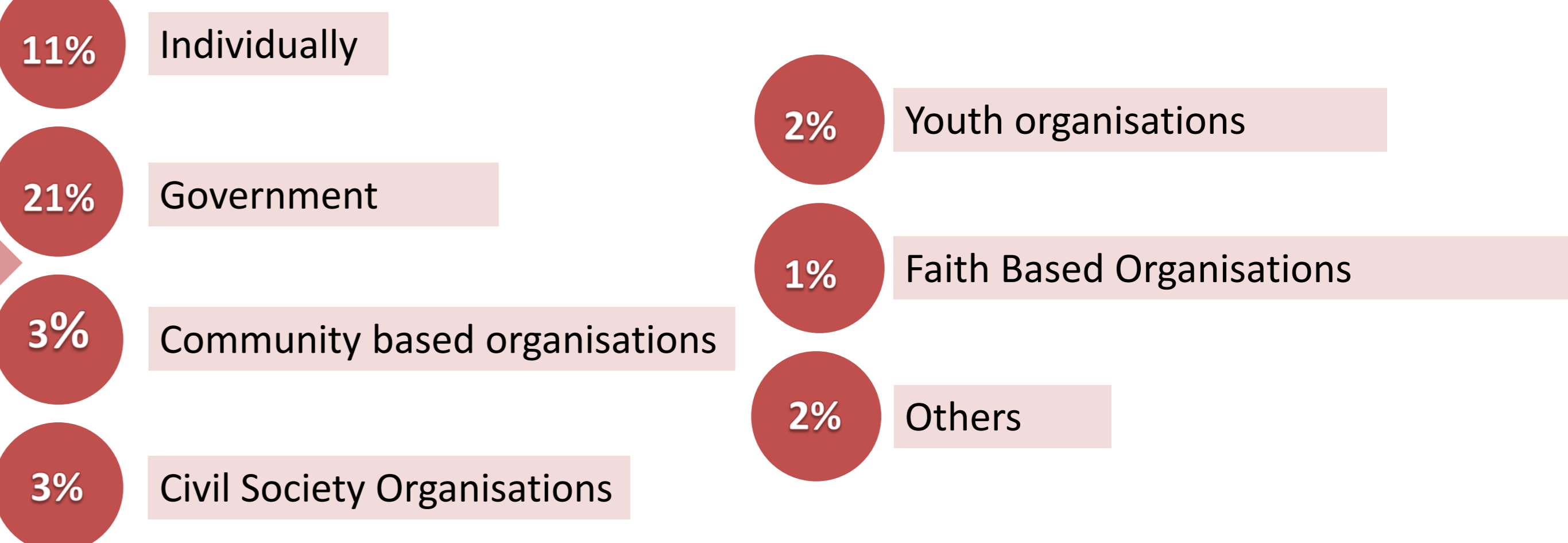


Youth mobilization in response to the COVID-19 pandemic

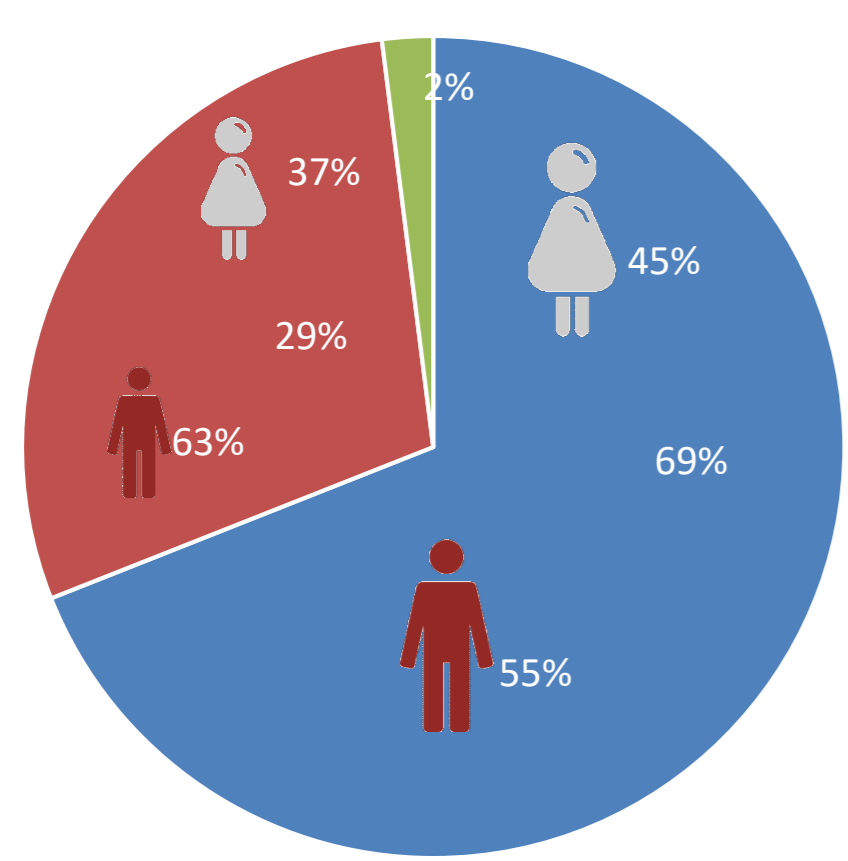
Youth mobilization to participate in the COVID-19 response



Who mobilized the youth to participate in the COVID-19 response?

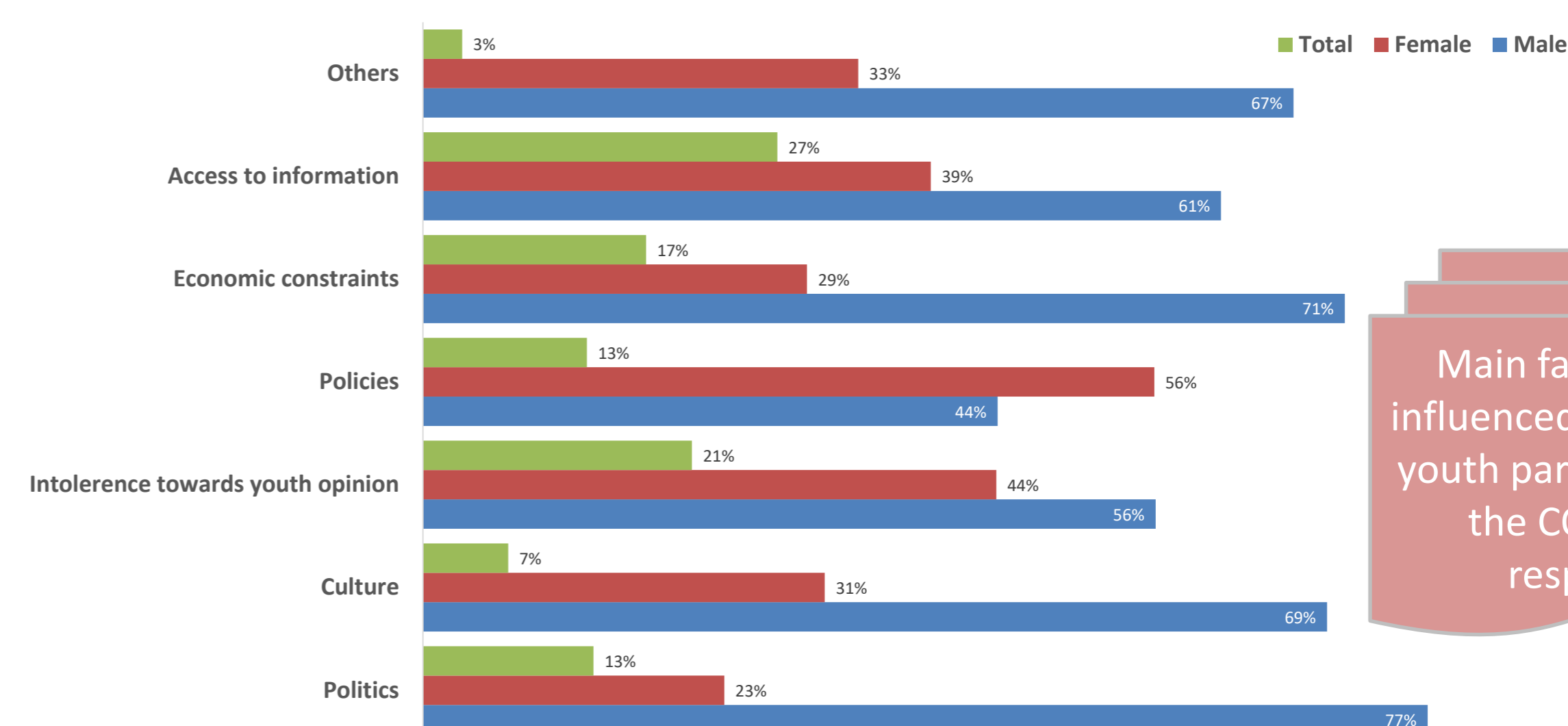


Form of youth participation in response to the COVID-19 pandemic



A majority of respondents participated in casual activities. Most of them feel that they don't have much, or any, say over important decisions, laws and policies affecting them.

Main factors that influenced the level of youth participation in the COVID-19 response

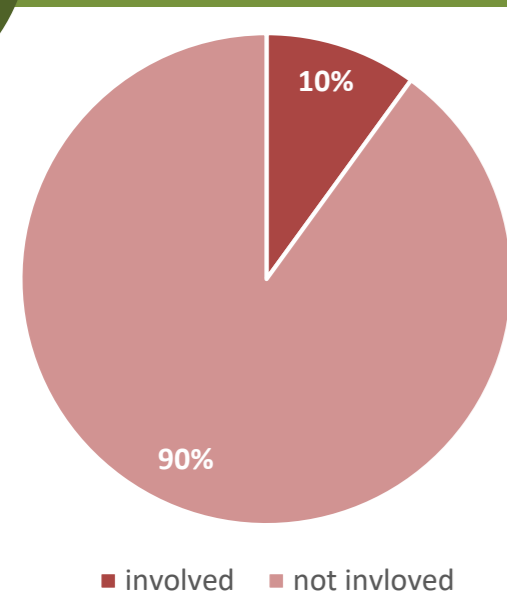


COVID-19 budgets and resources

- 68% Witnessed embezzlement of budget allocated for COVID-19
- 25% Fake companies used to embezzle budget allocated for COVID-19
- 87% Budgets allocated for the COVID-19 response were not made public
- 8% Participated in monitoring of COVID-19 budgets and related policy formulation



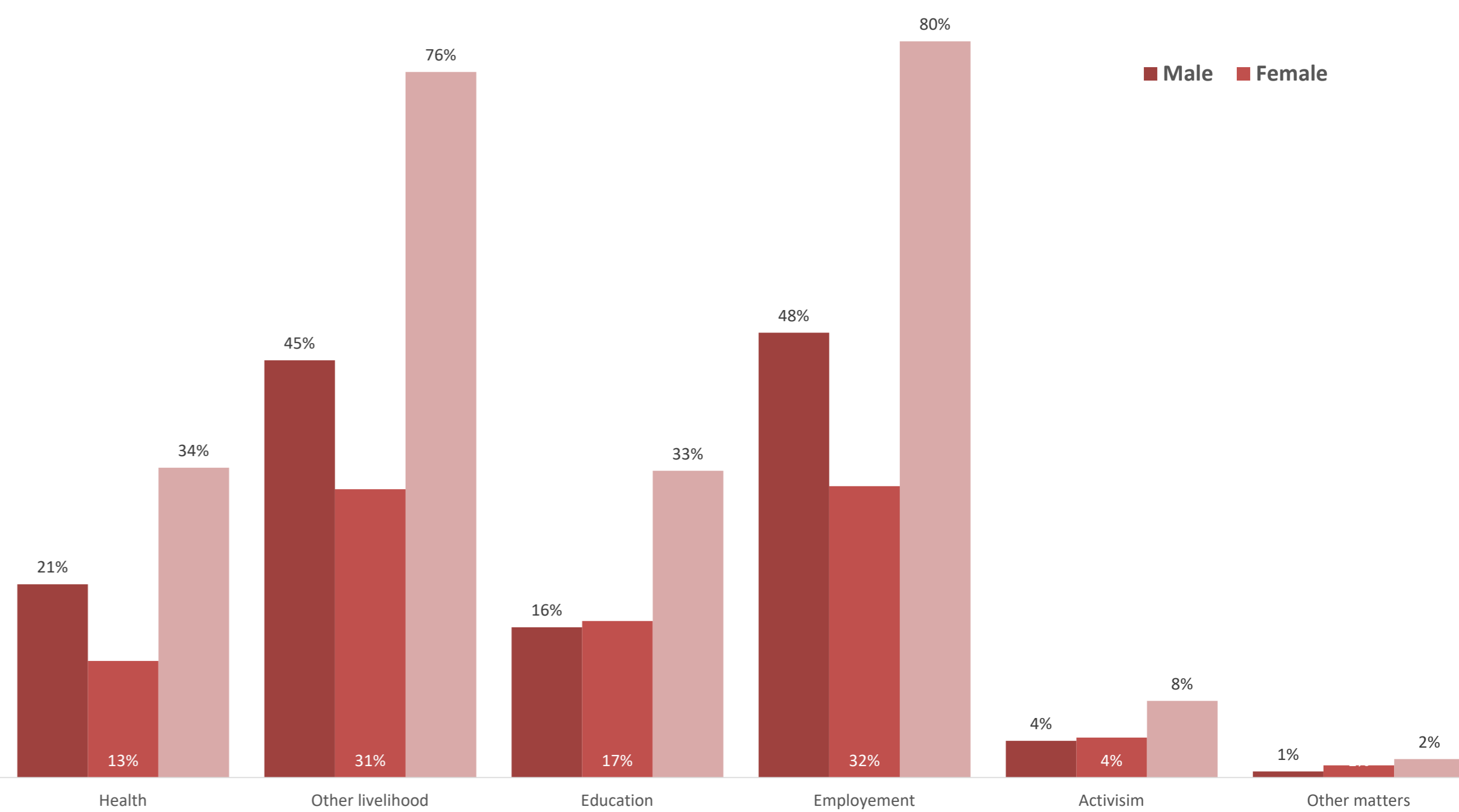
Participation in peace/security for COVID-19 response
